

- Gap up
- Keep up maintenance
- Increase density

- Coppice or pollard for wood fuel
- Trim every two to three years

Double the size of 20% of your hedges (at least)



Extend your hedgerow length by at least 20%



= 20% increase in height along 450m of a short (1.5m) hedge
